TARGET GROUP

The target group for the Leading Researchers Program (LRP) is group leaders and Post-Docs who are currently leading a team and have done so for at least 6 months. The program is open to all Austrian universities and research organizations.

12 participants will be selected according to an application process.

The program language is English.



PROGRAM MODULES & ELEMENTS

The program is composed of three 2-day-modules focusing on different aspects of leadership. Peer group sessions, potential analysis on emotional intelligence as well as individual leadership coaching complement the Leading Researchers Program.



KICK-OFF SESSION

In this 2-hour online meeting, you will be introduced to the program's structure and its key elements. You'll have the opportunity to get to know your fellow participants as well as our experienced leadership trainers and set the next steps for your individual leadership support.



MODULE 1

How can I lead myself? You explore the concept of self-leadership and the importance of leading from the inside out. You will reflect on your role as a leader in the context of your organization.




POTENTIAL ANALYSIS ON EMOTIONAL INTELLIGENCE

The results of this potential analysis will support you in reflecting on your individual leadership style with a certified coach, focusing on interpersonal competencies, stress management as well as decision making.



MODULE 2

How can I lead my team? This module equips you with the essential skills to foster a positive work environment, handle conflicts effectively and communicate with more clarity. You will explore the concept of Positive Leadership and the PERMA model.





MODULE 3

How can I lead in times of change? You deepen your understanding of strategic leadership in change processes and how to effectively deal with resistance and uncertainty within your team. You refine your communication strategies involving the unique dynamics of change within scientific contexts.



PEER GROUP SESSIONS

How can I integrate my learnings in my leadership role? You will reflect in groups of 3-4 on the leadership topics covered in the previous module. In this 2-hour online sessions, you share experiences and support each other in tackling leadership challenges. Our trainers will provide valuable insights and guidance to further enhance your leadership capabilities.



INDIVIDUAL 1:1 COACHINGS

You will work on your specific leadership & management topics with an experienced leadership coach in a 1:1 setting. Besides having more clarity on your topics, you will reflect on options and tools, which support you in your current role. You can use up to 3 hours of coaching until the end of the Leading Researchers Program.



POST-SESSION & ALUMNI GET-TOGETHER

You will reconnect with your fellow participants to reflect on your learnings and assess how your leadership role has evolved since the beginning of the program. This half day event in Vienna will be rounded off by a reception with Alumni of the Leading Researchers Program.

In your 3-minute video statement, please share:

- 1 Your name, your current role and the organization your work for

- **4** What question from your role as a leader would you like to answer in the course of the program?
- **5** What are you currently struggling with in your leadership role and how could you imagine the Program to support you?
- **6** How do you deal with change and what implications does change have for your leadership role and your team?
